CHECK HOLDS NOTICE

Effective July 1, 2025, the following regulatory changes for check holds will occur:

- 1) The minimum amount available the next business day for certain checks (e.g., local checks) will rise from \$225 to \$275.
- 2) For checks with a one-day hold, the amount available for cash withdrawal will increase from \$450 to \$550.
- The threshold for large deposit holds will increase from \$5,525 to \$6,725.

With rewards for making deposits, our Kids Club helps parents teach responsible saving & spending.

A Kids Club account is great for depositing allowance and birthday money. A parent, guardian or adult family member can open a youthmember account for a child. When they do, their child becomes a member of our Kids Club. Kids Club members enjoy rewards, contests and events all year long.



Kids who are 13 and older are eligible for an account debit card, with parent's approval.

Members under age 21 yrs are not required to maintain minimum balance to avoid low balance fee.

Open a Kids Club or Teen Member account with a \$5 deposit.

Note: Have your child's Social Security number and a copy of their birth certificate when you apply.

workshops for students in kindergarten through 12th grade. Our interactive sessions introduce students to essential topics like earning income, budgeting, using credit wisely, saving vs. investing, and understanding student debt. Each workshop is designed to meet students where they are, making complex topics simple, engaging, and age appropriate.

Currently, we partner with Taylor High School, Taylor Prep, and River Rouge STEM Academy, with plans to expand into more schools this year. Workshops are flexible and can be tailored to fit classroom's schedule, interests, even requests from students and staff.
